## What will I need to provide?

You will need to provide:

- A small range of pencils, 2H, HB and 2B.
- A basic set of watercolours.
- A set of watercolour brushes (synthetic brushes will be fine)
- A good quality A3 watercolour sketchbook
- Palette (or an old plate)
- 2 x water pots (jam jars will be fine)

The tutor will give you information of additional resources which will be required during the course, costs will be kept to a minimum.

It is recommended that you do not make any expensive purchases before speaking to the tutor.
